Program Details

Edunet Foundation, has launched the Academy of Careers in Technology, a transformative skilling initiative aimed at empowering youth in Hyderabad with in-demand technology and career-readiness skills.

This program targets students who meet the following criteria:

- Completed 12th grade in 2025 or 2026
- Not currently enrolled in any other course or program
- Aged 18 years or older
- Committed to dedicating 15 months to the program
- Willing to attend an in-person training program in Hyderabad
- Open to seeking employment in the IT sector and relocating if required

The initiative is designed to equip aspiring students in its initial cohort with a comprehensive curriculum focused on full-stack development and placement preparedness. A unique feature of the program is its year-long blend of classroom-based instruction and three months of intensive, project-based experiential learning, ensuring that participants gain both a strong conceptual foundation and real-world problem-solving skills.

Objective

The purpose of this RFP is to invite eligible agencies with proven expertise in mobilizing beneficiaries from marginalized communities, in alignment with the prerequisites defined above.

Scope of Work

- Mobilize 1,000 eligible beneficiaries by 30th May 2026
- Conduct community outreach and engagement activities
- Coordinate with local stakeholders to amplify the project's reach
- Ensure successful registration of beneficiaries on the online portal
- Schedule bi-weekly calls to report progress on mobilization and share the plan of action
- Monitor and report the progress of on-ground implementation

Mobilization Locations: Telangana and Andhra Pradesh

Timeline of Mobilization: 15th May 2026 – 15th June 2026

Financials: INR 400/- will be provided for each eligible beneficiary registered on Edunet's portal for the program. Total mobilization of 1,000 eligible beneficiaries.

Eligibility for applying organisations

- The proposing organisation must be at least 3–5 years old and should have experience implementing similar CSR projects for companies.
- The organization should be based in Telangana or Andhra Pradesh.
- Prior experience in community engagement and mobilization is required.

Interested organizations should submit a proposal that includes the following:

- **Detailed Approach and Methodology:** A thorough explanation of the proposed approach and methodology for community engagement specific to this program.
- **References:** References from past performance, highlighting successful community engagement and mobilization efforts.
